The donation will be disbursed in \$2,000 increments over the course of the next five years, and will be allocated towards upcoming expenses associated with renovations at the Mystic Branch. The proposed renovation will transform the existing 27,746-square-foot building into a 40,000-square-foot complex featuring a community room, teen center, gymnasium, pool, child watch center, spinning room and much more.
